The Institution-Wide Committee met on Monday, April 23, 2012 and the following

actions were taken:

The Committee considered the:

- (a) Approval of the Minutes of March 26, 2012
- (b) Revision to Article III Section 2 of the Student Code of Conduct

Action taken: The proposal with revisions will be returned to the Dean of Students and will be resubmitted.

(c) Revision to Article IV of the Student Code of Conduct

The revision will more clearly define the informal and formal judicial processes as well as the student appeals process focusing on clarity of wording and formatting. Changes also will more clearly define the informal process for handling disruptive behavior and obstruction of teaching in the classroom to make it align with College policy.

Action taken: Recommend approval of the revision.

(d) Proposed Involuntary Leave of Absence Policy

Action taken: Table for further discussion.

(e) Revision to Associate in Arts in Psychology

Changes in the curriculum are:

1. Creation of a new course PSYC 167 (Foundations of Statistical Methods for Social and Behavioral Sciences) which will replace Math 251 (Statistics for Science).

- 2. Creation of a new course PSYC 210 (Experimental Research methods in Psychology) which will replace a general elective.
- 3. Rename and revise PSYC 110 (Applied Psychology: Principles of Behavior in Everyday Life). The new name will be Descriptive Research Methods in Psychology.

Action taken: Recommend approval of the revision.

(f) Revision to Youth Work Academic Certificate

The change to the certificate involves removing CIS 100, which no longer exists, as an option.

Action taken: Recommend approval of the revision.
