General Information: CCP and Saint Joseph's College of Maine have entered into an agreement between the AAS in Diagnostic Medical Imaging at CCP and the online BS in Radiologic Science Administration at Saint Joseph's. A student who earns the AAS transfers to Saint Joseph's with advanced standing to the BS degree with an option of a progressive pathway to a Master of Health Administration. A grade of at least C must be earned for a course to transfer. At least 25% of coursework (32 credits) for the BS must be earned at Saint Joseph's. All application procedures must be followed. The application fee is waived for DMI students.
