Graduation this year will be at the <u>Liacouras Center</u>, located at 1776 North Broad Street. (Parking and driving directions can be obtained at their website: <u>www.liacourascenter.com</u>). The robing area is on the street-level in the Fox-Gittis room. The robing room is to the left if entering through the main entrance on Broad Street. Robing begins at 12:45pm. This year, graduation begins promptly at 2:00pm, and faculty will march and be seated before the students. Parking will be available at the Center for \$10 per car. The entrance to the Temple Parking Garage is at 15th and Montgomery. If you wish to car pool, the College will have the surface lot on 17th Street available free of charge on Sunday, May 4th.
